




Q1 What is the grade of the child for whom you are completing this survey?






Q2 How many children do you have at this school?


Q3 How far does your child live from school?








Q4 On most days, how does your child arrive at and leave from school?






Q7 My child already walks or bikes to/from school.






Q12 In your opinion, how much does your child's school encourage or discourage walking and biking to/from school?

Q13 How much fun is walking or biking for your child?



Q14 How healthy is walking or biking for your child?



1	Finding a crossing guard for the grove and Lincoln st intersection would be ideal. My kids (k and 2nd grade) will wait at the stop sign to cross until there is absolutely no cars and in the mornings that is highly uncommon for there to be little traffic there.	12/3/2023 5:55 AM
2	We do not allow our child to bike to school alone and never will, we always accompany him. We have to cross 8th St which can be dangerous. There are also so many people on their phones not paying attention to kids on bikes etc.	11/20/2023 2:35 PM
3	Personally, I bike to and from work all year long and in all weather conditions. My kids will bike to and from school during most fair weather conditions. Anything below 40 degrees is a struggle to keep them warm on the ride, especially going into the wind. I bike with them to establish the route and routine, but I also don't think they are quite old enough to go it alone. We plan our route to stay off busy streets and use the crossing guard to navigate past 8th Street. I have dreams that our local culture will embrace more walking and cycling but there are a combination of factors that make it highly unlikely. Our communities are too spread out for efficient means of human-powered travel. If someone has an e-bike or similar electric-assisted transportation device, they are more likely to make the commute because it requires little effort, takes less time, and is more convenient. I talk to people about biking to and from places all the time and I commonly hear excuses as to why someone can't or won't do something. 4	The 5th st and Grove intersection is dangerous due to obstacles/visibility and traffic.	11/20/2023 12:22 PM
5	There are sex offenders on my children's way to school so I do not know how they can take a safer route as there is no way around it.	11/20/2023 12:16 PM
6	Our street is by Sandlot Park, and our area has no sidewalks; traffic is too unpredictable to allow my children to walk. I have a 5th grader, a 2nd grader, and a kindergartener. I take them to school each day because there is no safe way or place for them to get the bus, much less walk to school. We discussed busing, but the route to get there is not safe. There are no sidewalks for them to use. Sampson Street is not patrolled, cars do not watch out for pedestrians, and the intersection on Pepper Ave and Sampson is hard enough for a car to cross that I cannot in good conscience let my kids cross on their own.
