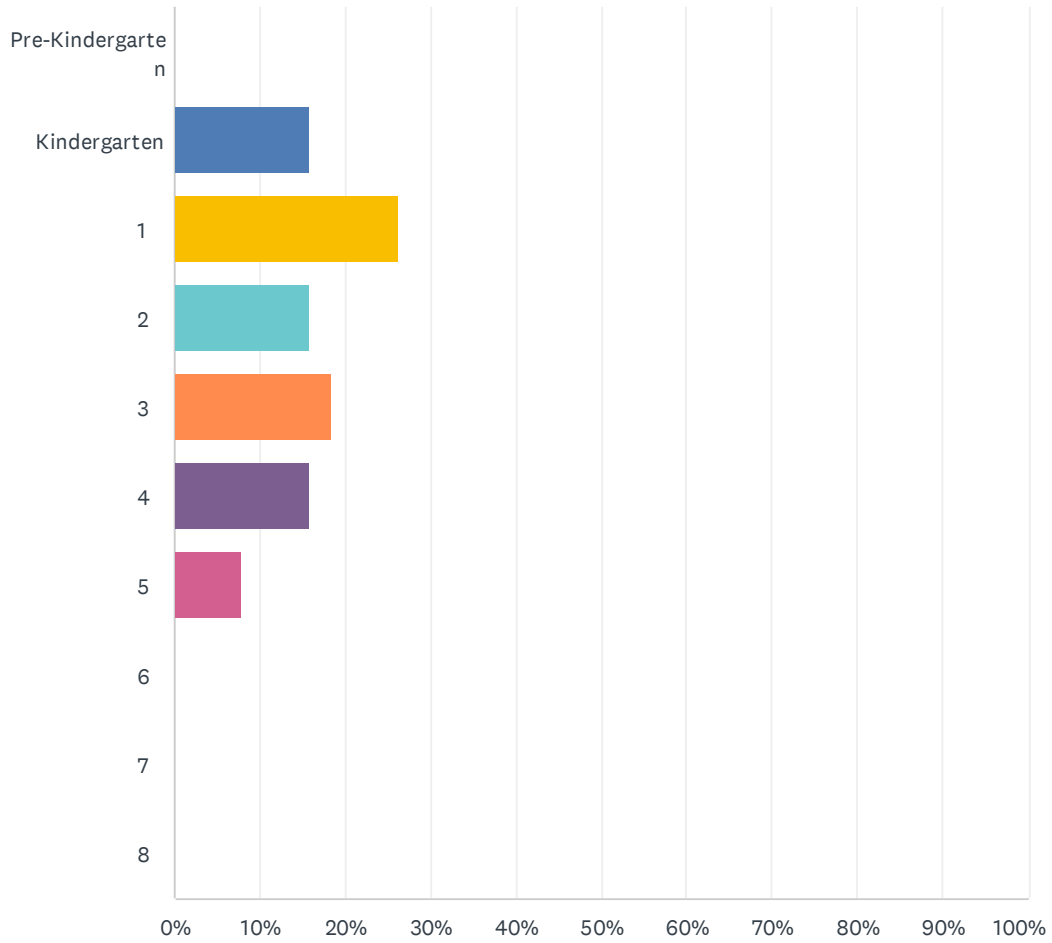

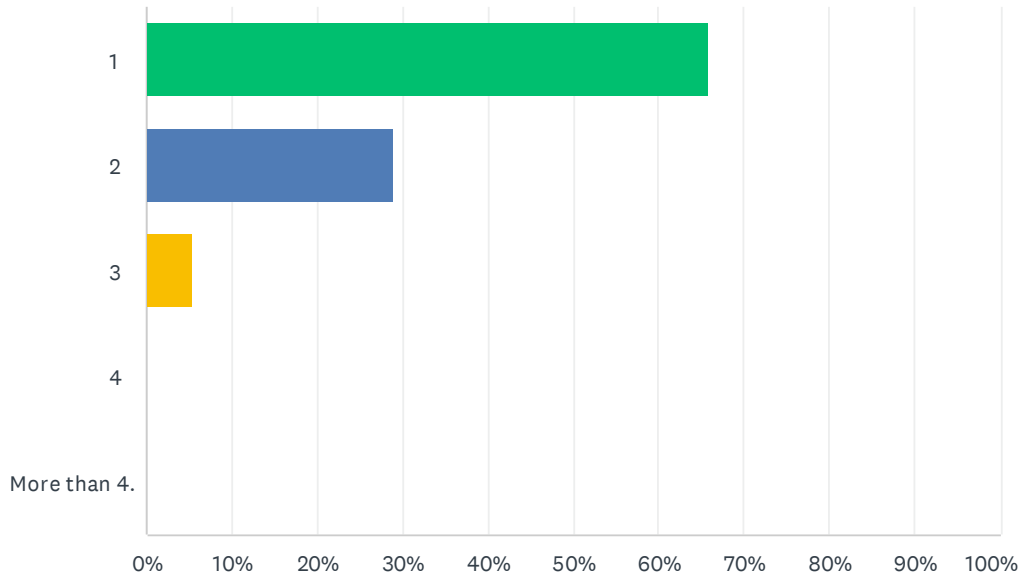

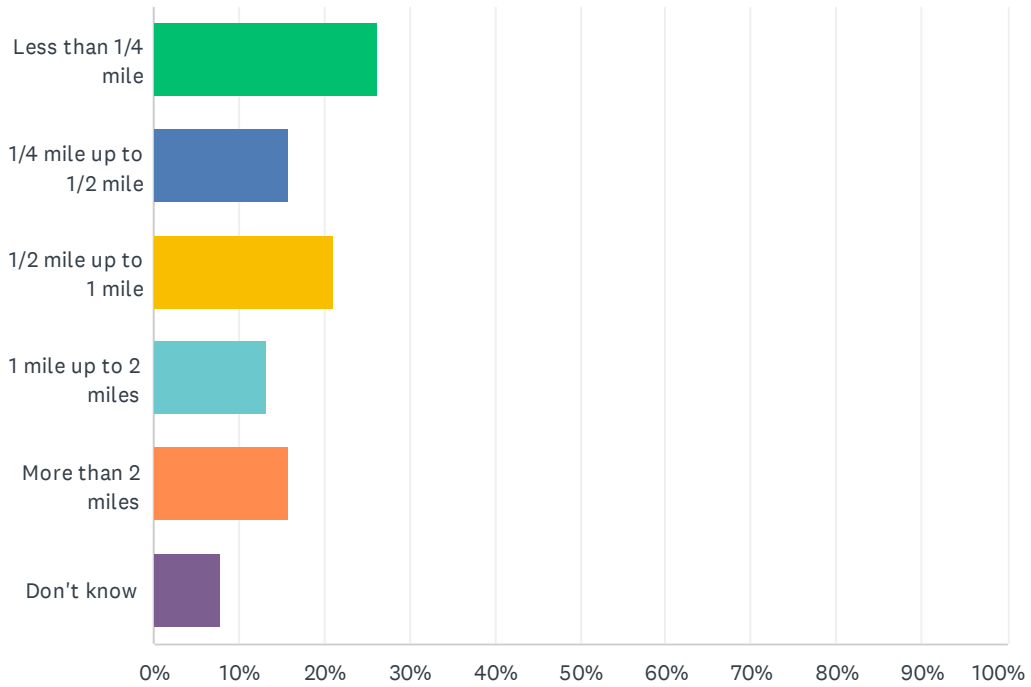

### Q3 How far does your child live from school?

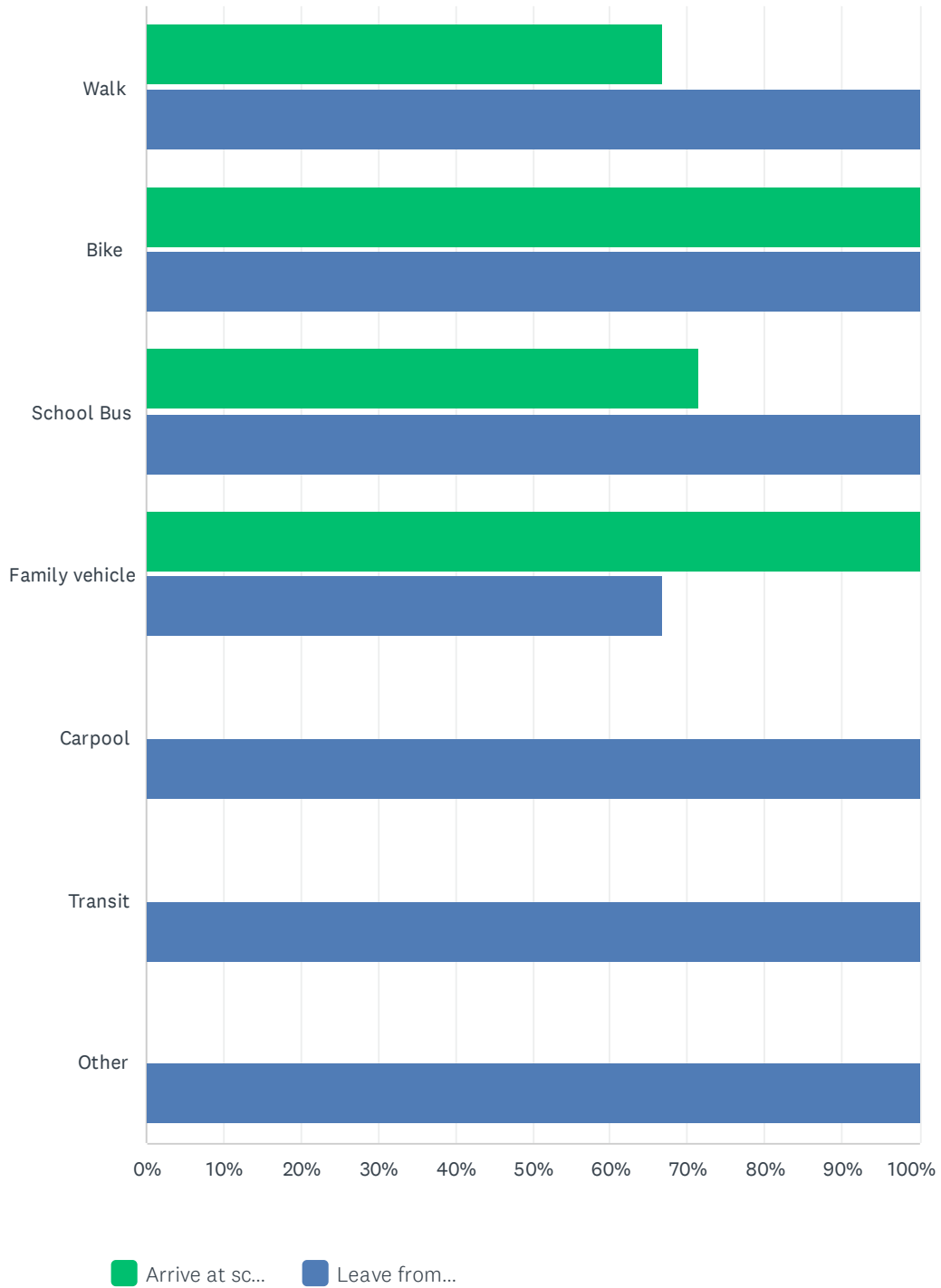

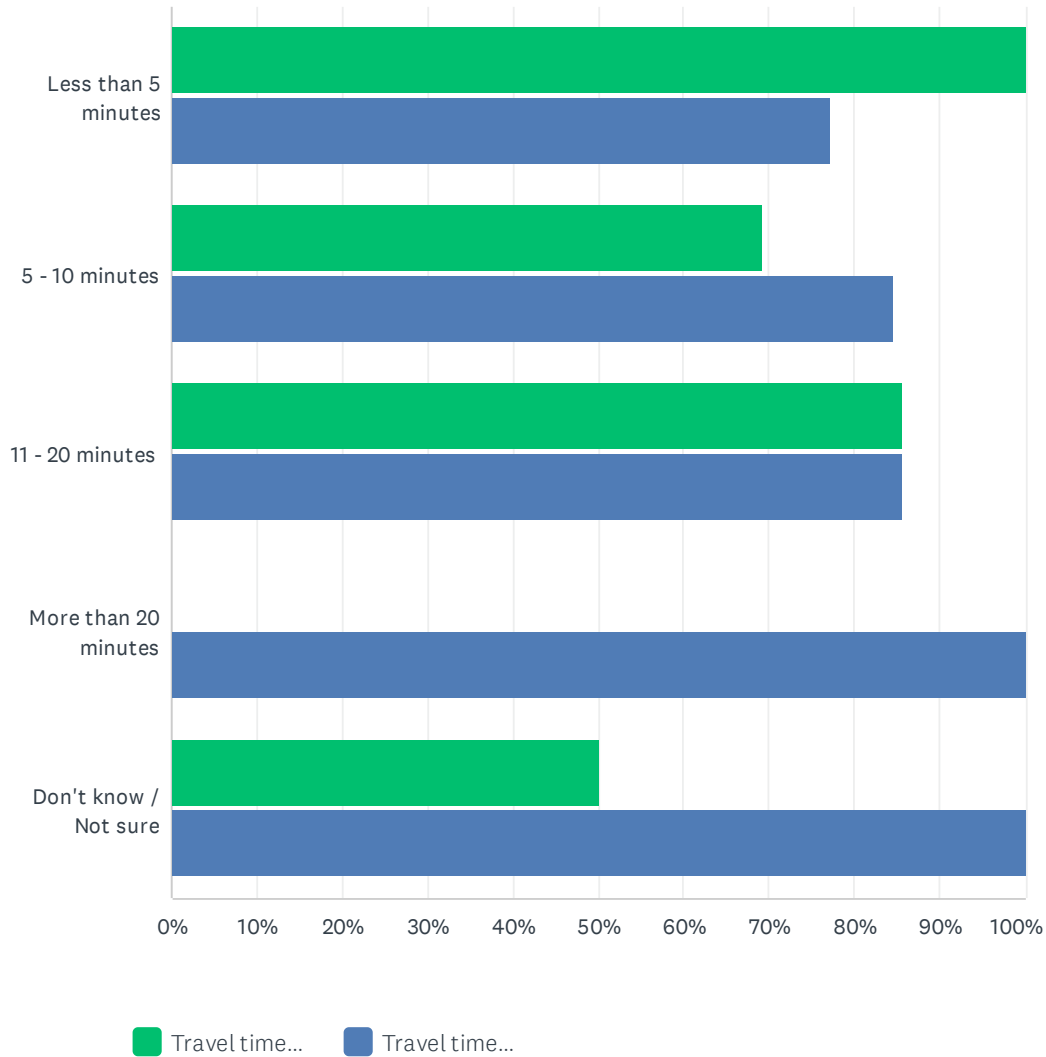

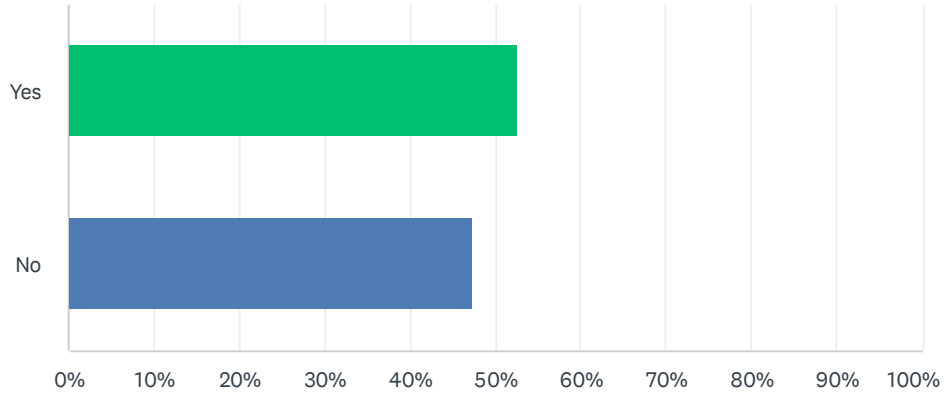

## Q6 Has your child asked you for permission to walk or bike to/from school in the last year?

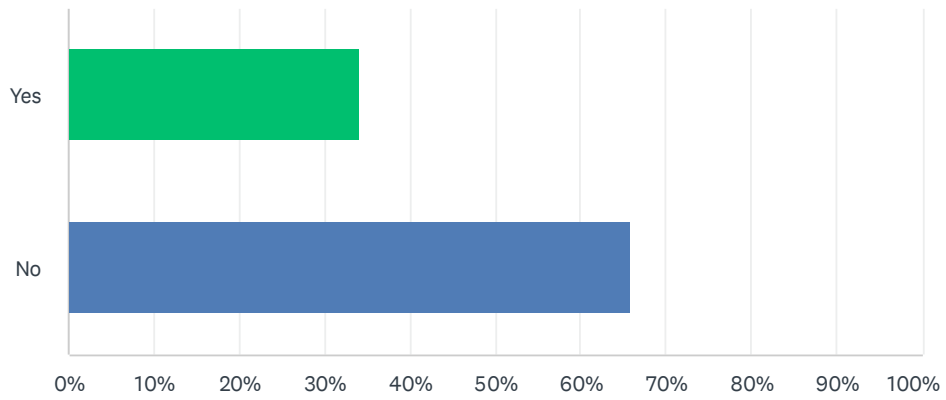

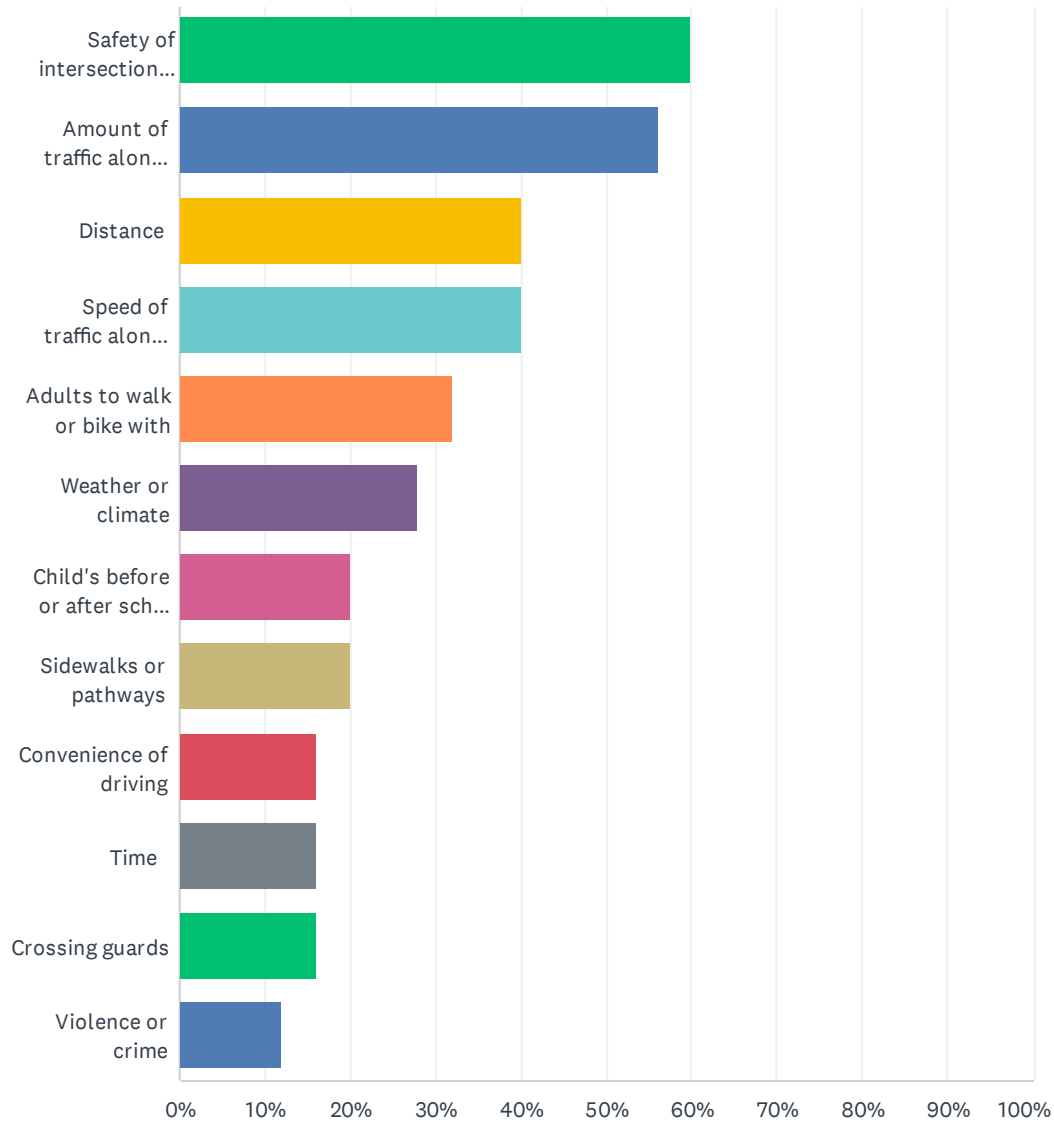

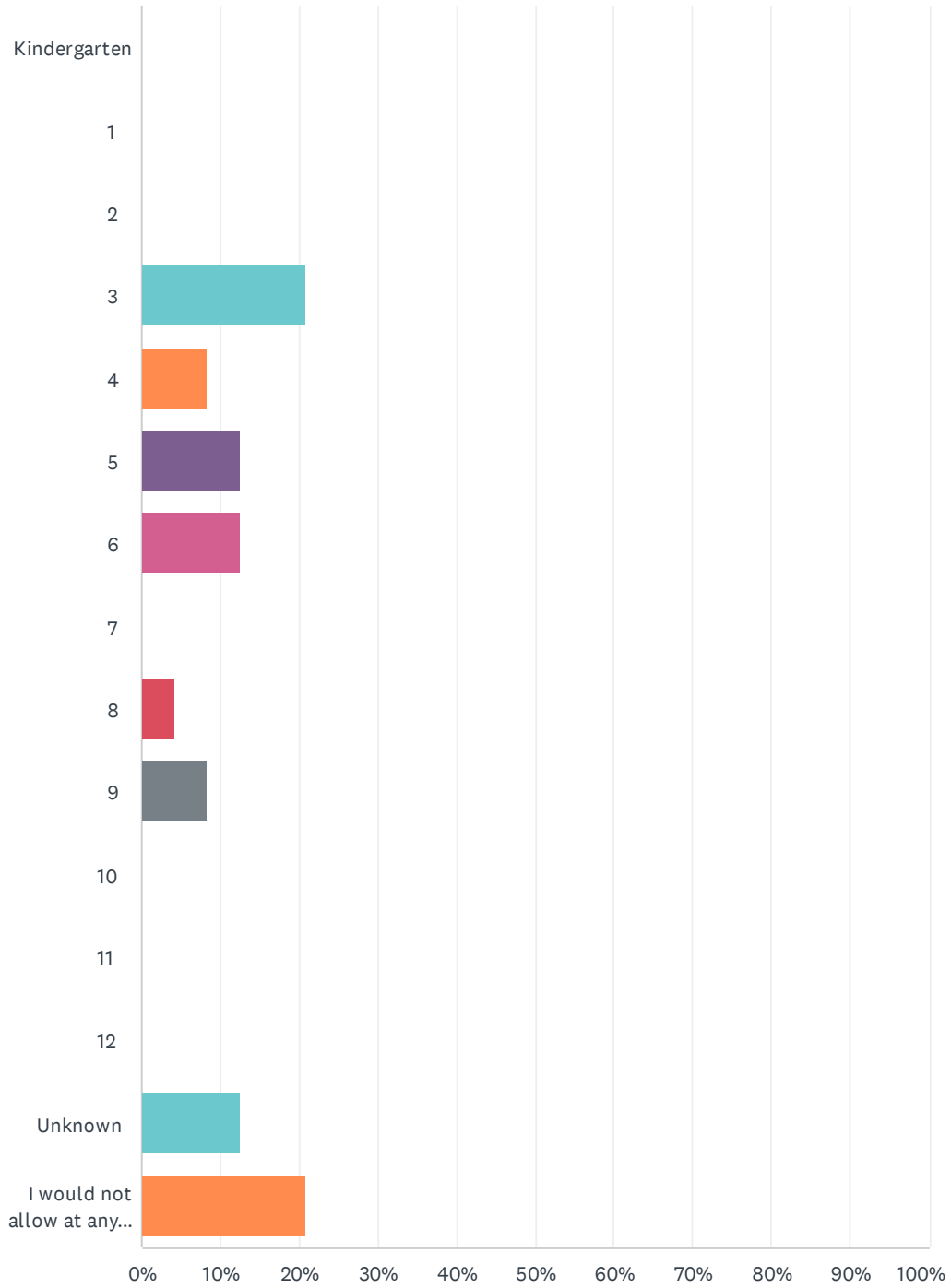

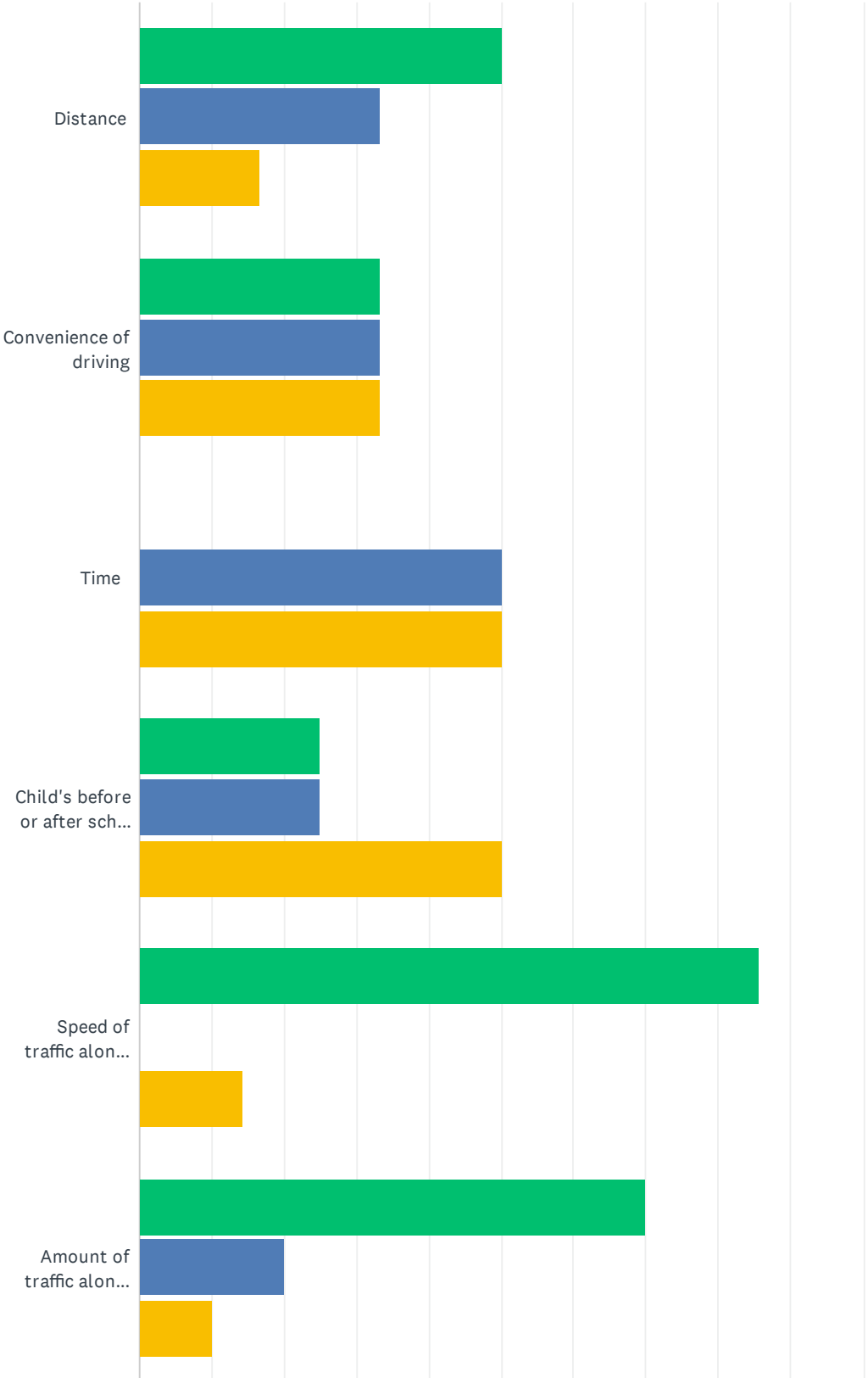
## Q10 Why do you not feel comfortable allowing your child to walk or bike at any grade?

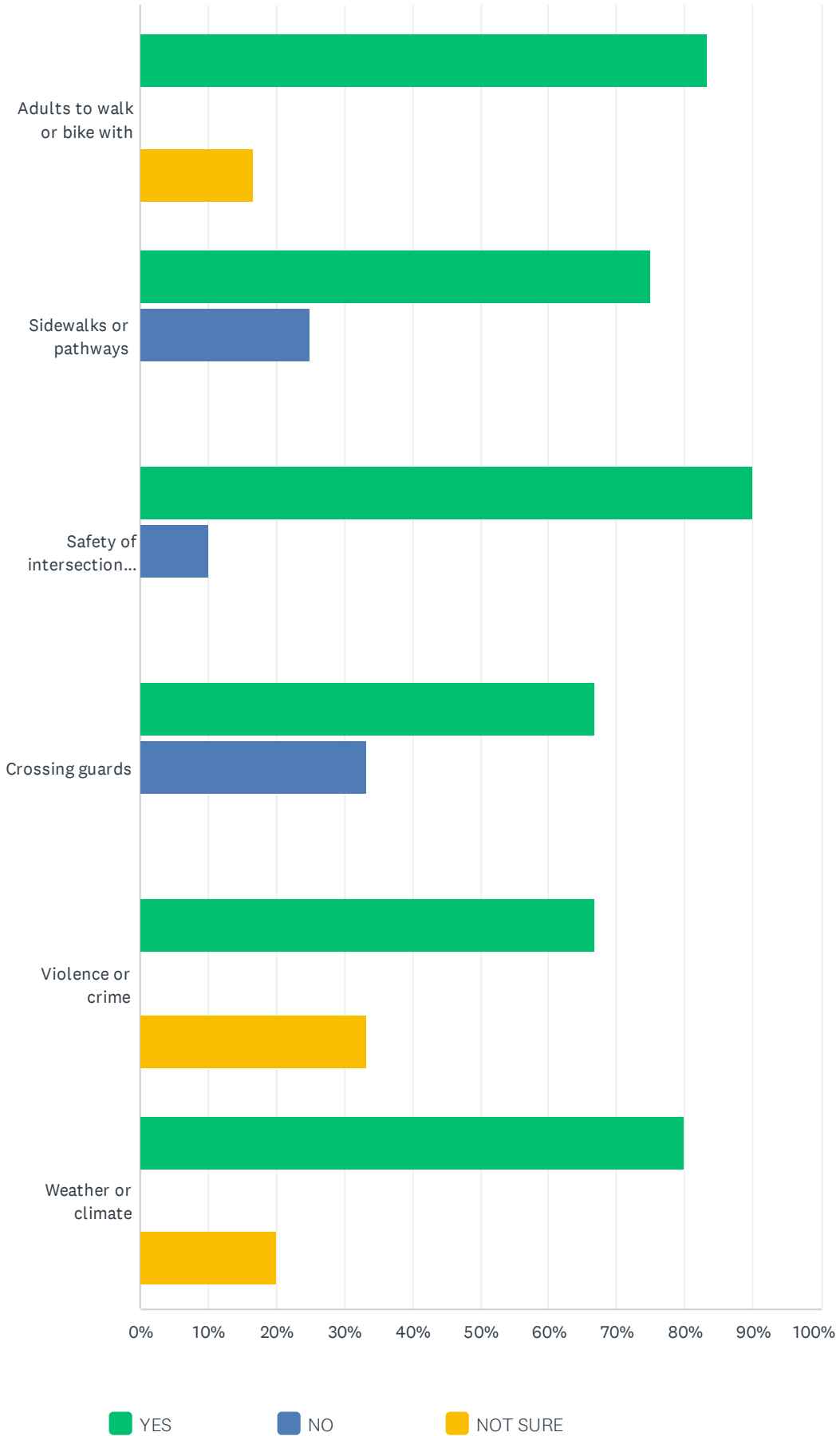

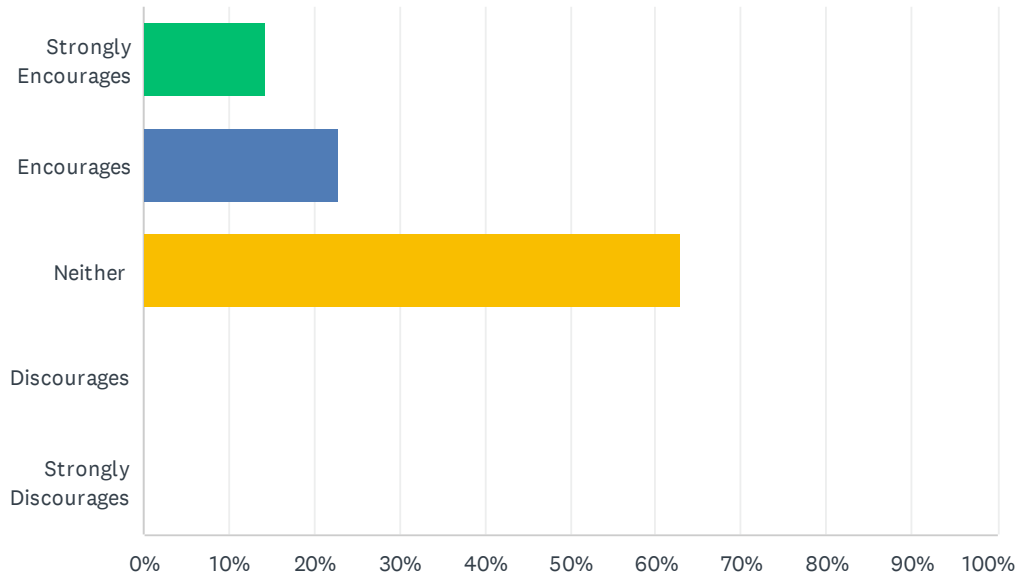

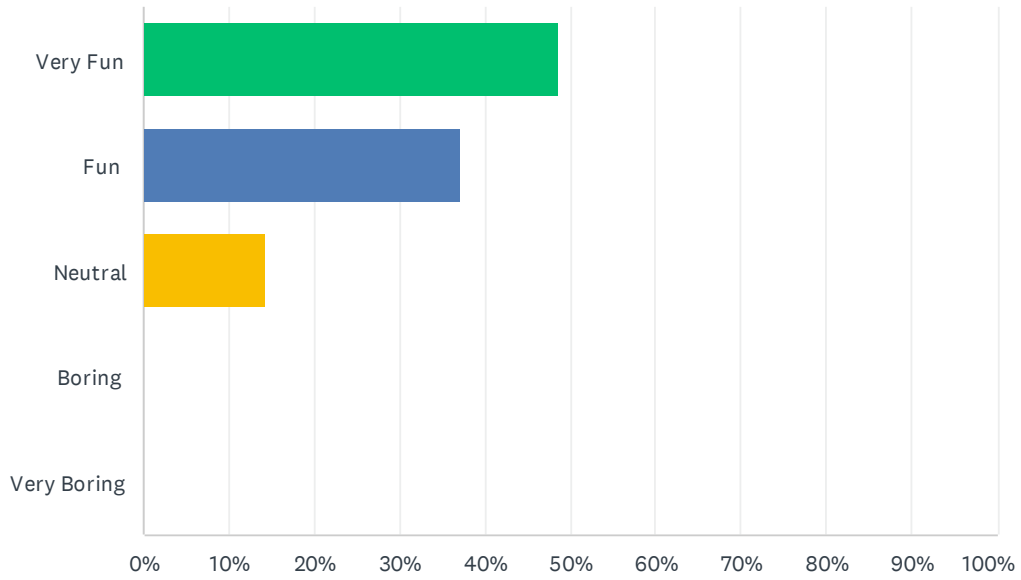

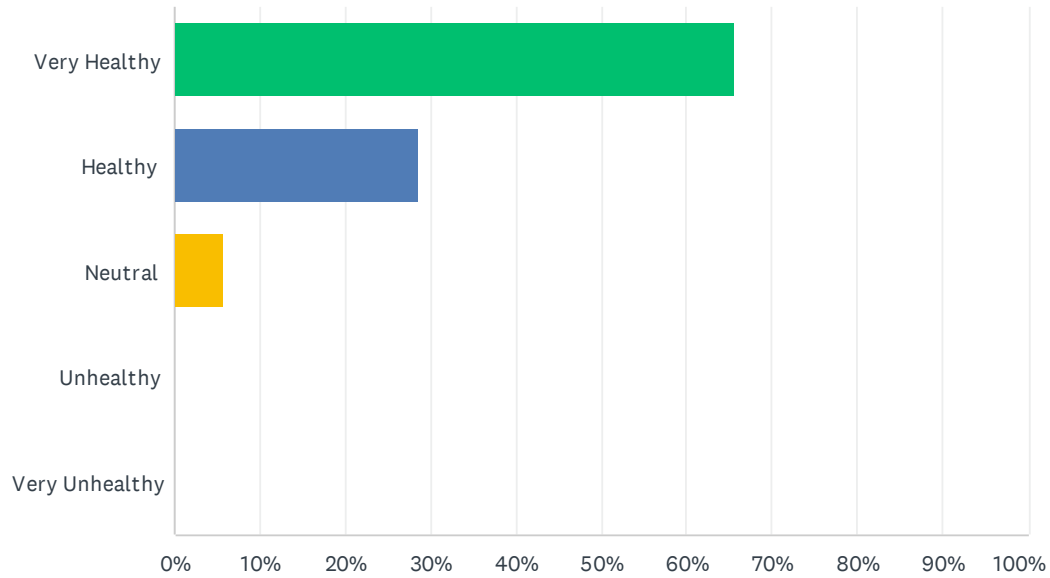

## Q14 How healthy is walking or biking for your child?

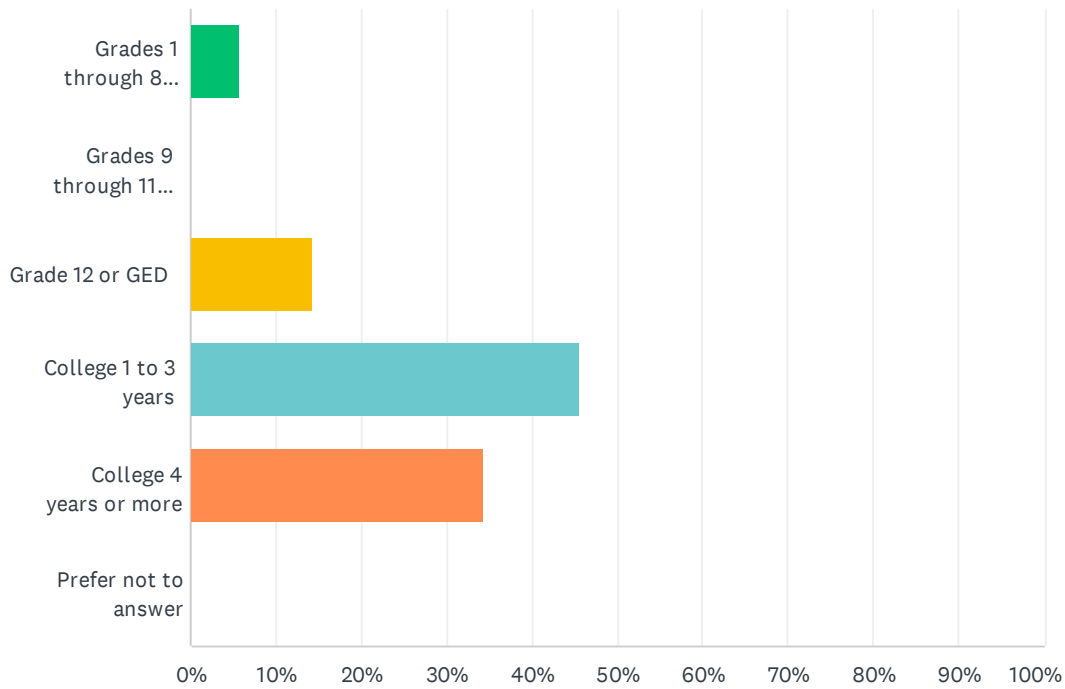
