




Q1 What is the grade of the child for whom you are completing this survey?


Q2 How many children do you have at this school?


Q3 How far does your child live from school?


Q4 On most days, how does your child arrive at and leave from school?











Q7 My child already walks or bikes to/from school.

Q8 Which of the following issues affected your decision to NOT allow your child to walk or bike to/from school? (Select ALL that apply.)






Q12 In your opinion, how much does your child's school encourage or discourage walking and biking to/from school?

Q13 How much fun is walking or biking for your child?



Q14 How healthy is walking or biking for your child?


