




# Q1 What is the grade of the child for whom you are completing this survey?


## Q2 How many children do you have at this school?


## Q3 How far does your child live from school?


### Q4 On most days, how does your child arrive at and leave from school?











## Q7 My child already walks or bikes to/from school.





# Q12 In your opinion, how much does your child's school encourage or discourage walking and biking to/from school?




## Q13 How much fun is walking or biking for your child?



## Q14 How healthy is walking or biking for your child?


